Lady Norah is a well-crafted 35ft traditional stern narrowboat, built by Union Mill Narrowboats in 1999. Designed with comfort and practicality in mind, she offers a cosy and well-thought-out living space, making her an excellent choice for both leisure cruising and long-term stays on the water.

Step into the engine room before making your way to the master bedroom, which features a comfortable double bed with storage underneath, maximising space and functionality. The warm and inviting interior creates a restful retreat, perfect for extended stays aboard.

The bathroom is well-appointed, with a sink and vanity unit, a shower, and a cassette toilet. Thoughtfully designed, this space ensures a balance of practicality and comfort.

The galley is both functional and efficient, featuring a stainless-steel sink, a gas hob and grill, an oven, and a 12v fridge (new in 2024). The compact yet well-equipped kitchen provides everything needed for preparing meals while onboard.

The saloon offers a welcoming and comfortable space to relax, with a 6ft bench that converts into a single bed and a chair for additional seating. A 12v/mains-powered TV adds to the convenience, making this an ideal area for unwinding after a day on the water.

Heating and hot water are supplied by a Webasto system, which powers three radiators throughout the boat, while a Rinnai water heater, calorifier, and Webasto system provide hot water on demand. The boat is also equipped with a 240v electric supply via a shoreline consumer unit in the engine bay, with a galvanic isolator for added protection.

Externally, Lady Norah benefits from front and rear covers, providing shelter from the elements. A roof-mounted storage box with a cover offers additional storage for equipment and supplies.

With a Boat Safety Certificate valid until August 2027, new domestic batteries fitted in May 2024, and a reliable Isuzu 3LD28 engine, Lady Norah is a fantastic opportunity for anyone looking for a well-maintained, compact, and practical narrowboat.
